During the late 70's and 80's Didier worked in various famous restaurants in France as a Chef and Sous-Chef, including the French President's residence, l'Elysee. He joined the French Accor Group in 1990 and worked for the Sofitel Hotel resorts as Executive Chef travelling the world setting up the Solitel kitchens and training staff. Didier finally settled in Australia in 2007 where he opened the first crepe and patisserie shop in Cairns, called Sweet Bistro and a year later opened a second in Palm Cove. In 2012 he moved to Perth and has opened Paris Crepes Café in Fremantle.
